1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Indiana War
2 Memorials Commission to study and propose the construction
3 of a suitable monument to the men and women of Indiana who
4 died in the service of their country in the global war on
5 terrorism.

6 *Whereas, The global war on terrorism is regarded as the*
7 *longest war fought to date in American history;*

8 *Whereas, The United States and its allies fought in many*
9 *countries around the world to suppress and deter terrorism*
10 *following the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001;*

11 *Whereas, Soldiers, sailors, airmen, and Marines from Indiana*
12 *fought in every theater of the war that lasted nearly 20 years;*

13 *Whereas, Two hundred seven men and women from Indiana*
14 *died in the service of their country in the global war on*
15 *terrorism;*

16 *Whereas, Hoosiers from small towns, big cities, and every*
17 *region of the state fought in the global war on terrorism so that*
18 *every part of Indiana has been affected by the loss of those who*
19 *died;*

20 *Whereas, Hoosiers are grateful for the service and dedication*
21 *to duty of our neighbors who made the ultimate sacrifice in the*
22 *global war on terrorism;*

23 *Whereas, Hoosiers have expressed their gratitude for the*
24 *service and dedication to duty of the service members from*



1 *Indiana who died in earlier wars through the construction of*
 2 *suitable and inspiring monuments; and*

3 *Whereas, It is altogether fitting and proper that the State of*
 4 *Indiana construct and dedicate a suitable monument to those*
 5 *brave and honorable Hoosiers who made the ultimate sacrifice*
 6 *in the global war on terrorism: Therefore,*

7 *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives*
 8 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
 9 *the Senate concurring:*

10 SECTION 1. That the Indiana War Memorials Commission
 11 study and propose the construction of a suitable monument to
 12 the men and women of Indiana who died in the service of their
 13 country in the global war on terrorism.

14 SECTION 2. That the Indiana War Memorials Commission
 15 seek public comment and public involvement in studying and
 16 developing a monument proposal through meetings held around
 17 the state.

18 SECTION 3. That the Indiana War Memorials Commission
 19 seek to secure the involvement of design, engineering, and
 20 construction professionals of the highest caliber to ensure the
 21 development of a monument worthy of the men and women of
 22 Indiana who died in the service of their country in the global
 23 war on terrorism.

24 SECTION 4. That copies of this resolution be transmitted by
 25 the Principal Clerk of the House to Governor Eric Holcomb,
 26 Brigadier General J. Stewart Goodwin, Executive Director,
 27 Indiana War Memorials Commission, and Otto Frenzel IV,
 28 President, Board of Directors, Indiana War Memorials
 29 Foundation.
