

## HOUSE RESOLUTION No. \_\_\_\_

A HOUSE RESOLUTION recognizing the F&AM Masonic Lodge #341 in Greentown, Indiana.

Whereas, Indiana has over 50,000 Masons in almost 400
lodges throughout the state representing men from all walks of

5 *life*;

Whereas, Admission to a Masonic lodge is open to men of good character and faith, regardless of their race, color, religious beliefs, political views, sexual orientation, physical

9 ability, citizenship, or national origin;

Whereas, The Greentown F&AM Masonic Lodge #341 was originally chartered on May 29, 1867;

Whereas, The first master of the Greentown lodge, Mr.

13 Arland O. D. Kelley, was appointed in 1866;

1	Whereas, The first lodge building was purchased in 1872
2	and membership grew exponentially after a neighboring lodge,
3	Jerome Lodge #203, surrendered its charter in 1884;
4	Whereas, The Masons of the Greentown F&AM Masonic
5	Lodge #341 have met continuously for over 125 years and have
6	been an integral part of Greentown and the surrounding
7	community;
8	Whereas, The lodge building served as a school for children
9	from 1919 to 1920 while a new school was being built in the
10	area;
11	Whereas, The Freemasons of Greentown started a
12	scholarship program for students at Eastern High School in
13	2004 and have since awarded scholarships to 30 young adults
14	totaling over \$50,000;
15	Whereas, Freemasonry is the world's first, largest, and most
16	legendary fraternal organization, providing guidance and
17	leadership to Masons to become better husbands, fathers,
18	brothers, and citizens; and
19	Whereas, The Freemasons of Greentown continue to make
20	positive change in the communities that they serve: Therefore,
21	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the
22	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
23	SECTION 1. That the Indiana House of Representatives
24	recognizes the Greentown F&AM Masonic Lodge #341 for its
25	many years of contributions to the community.
26	SECTION 2. That the Principal Clerk of the House of
27	Representatives transmit copies of this resolution to Indiana
28	State Representative Michael Karickhoff for distribution.
