1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION celebrating Indiana Senior Day 2 at the Indiana Statehouse on March 5, 2019.

Whereas, Nearly 16 percent of Hoosiers are 65 years of age or older, according to data published by the United States Census Bureau in 2017;

6 Whereas, By 2030, one out of every five people living in 7 Indiana will be a senior citizen (ages 65 and older), according 8 to population projections released by the Indiana Business

Whereas, Senior citizens continue to play vital roles in the growth and development of Indiana with many contributions to the economy, culture, and history of Indiana;
