Citations Affected: IC 4-23.

Synopsis: Native American Indian affairs commission. Provides that a member of a historical tribe of Indiana is a Native American Indian for purposes of the Native American Indian affairs commission.

Effective: July 1, 2016.

SENATE BILL No. 13

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 4-23-32-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.7-2015,
2 SECTION 3, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "Native American
4 Indian" means an individual who is at least one (1) of the following:
5 (1) An Alaska native as defined in 43 U.S.C. 1602(b).
6 (2) An Indian as defined in 25 U.S.C. 450b(d).
7 (3) A native Hawaiian as defined in 20 U.S.C. 7517(1).
8 **(4) A member of a historical tribe of Indiana that meets the**
9 **following requirements:**
10 **(A) The tribe maintains current tribal rolls.**
11 **(B) Indiana is the repository of the tribal rolls.**
