DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-18.1-14-11.

Synopsis: Operation of off-road vehicles. Exempts the following individuals from the requirement of wearing a helmet while operating or riding on an off-road vehicle if the off-road vehicle is equipped with a roll cage: (1) An individual at least eight years of age who operates or rides on the off-road vehicle while wearing a safety belt. (2) An individual less than eight years of age who rides on the off-road vehicle while restrained in a child restraint system in accordance with state law. Defines "roll cage".

Effective: July 1, 2018.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

3	JULY 1, 2018]: Sec. 11. (a) As used in this section, "roll cage"
4	means a framework of reinforcements fitted around the passenger
5	compartment of a vehicle to protect the occupants from injury in
6	the event of a vehicle rollover.
7	(a) (b) Except as provided in subsection (c), an individual less
8	than eighteen (18) years of age who is operating or riding on an
9	off-road vehicle shall wear a helmet that meets the standards
10	established by the United States Department of Transportation under
11	49 CFR 571.218 as in effect January 1, 1979.
12	(c) This section does not apply to the following individuals if the
13	off-road vehicle is equipped with a roll cage:
14	(1) An individual at least eight (8) years of age who operates
15	or rides on the off-road vehicle while wearing a safety belt.
16	(2) An individual less than eight (8) years of age who rides on
