Synopsis: Paid employee leave. Urges the legislative council to assign to an appropriate interim study committee during the 2022 legislative interim the task of studying paid personal leave from employment.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning labor and safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **(a) The legislative**
2 **council is urged to assign to the appropriate interim study**
3 **committee, during the 2022 legislative interim, the task of studying**
4 **paid personal leave from employment, including leave taken for the**
5 **following reasons:**
6 **(1) Family leave.**
7 **(2) Leave to care for a seriously ill family member.**
8 **(3) Employee sick leave.**
9 **(b) This SECTION expires January 1, 2023.**
10 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
