DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 24-5.

**Synopsis:** Extension of lemon law protection to RVs. Provides that recreational vehicles are included within the definition of "motor vehicle" or "vehicle" for purposes of motor vehicle protection laws.

Effective: July 1, 2024.
