DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 33-33-49-2.

Synopsis: Marion circuit court magistrate. Allows the judge of the Marion circuit court to appoint one full-time magistrate to serve the circuit court. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the interim study committee on courts and the judiciary.)

Effective: July 1, 2016.

SENATE BILL No. 27

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 33-33-49-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 2. **(a)** Marion County
3 constitutes the nineteenth judicial circuit.
4 **(b) The judge of the Marion circuit court may appoint one (1)**
5 **full-time magistrate under IC 33-23-5 to serve the circuit court.**
6 **The magistrate continues in office until removed by the judge.**
