## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 22-11-3.1-7.

**Synopsis:** Local licensing boards in Lake and Porter counties. Provides that a member of a board or other entity in Lake County or Porter County that issues a license, registration, or certificate required for a contractor to do business in the geographic area served by the board or entity must be at least 18 years of age, and except for an ex-officio member, a resident of the geographic area served by the board or entity. Provides that a member who ceases to be a resident of the geographic area served by the board or entity is considered to have resigned as a member of the board or entity, and the vacancy is filled as specified by ordinance.

**Effective:** July 1, 2018.

# SENATE BILL No. 31

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning labor and safety.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 22-11-3.1-7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 2018]: **Sec. 7. (a) This section applies to:**  
4 (1) a county described in section 2 of this chapter; or  
5 (2) a municipality (as defined in IC 36-1-2-11) in a county  
6 described in subdivision (1);  
7 **that has a contractor board.**  
8 (b) As used in this section, "contractor board" means a board  
9 or other entity that issues a license, registration, or certificate  
10 required for a contractor to do business in the geographic area  
11 served by the board or entity.  
12 (c) A member of a contractor board must be:  
13 (1) at least eighteen (18) years of age; and  
14 (2) except for an ex-officio member, a resident of the  
15 geographic area served by the contractor board.  
16 (d) This subsection does not apply to an ex-officio member of a  
17 contractor board. A member of a contractor board who ceases to



1     **be a resident of the geographic area served by the board is**  
2     **considered to have resigned from the board. A board vacancy**  
3     **created under this subsection is filled as specified by ordinance.**
