DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 22-11-3.1-7.

Synopsis: Local licensing boards in Lake and Porter counties. Provides that a member of a board or other entity in Lake County or Porter County that issues a license, registration, or certificate required for a contractor to do business in the geographic area served by the board or entity must be at least 18 years of age, and except for an ex-officio member, a resident of the geographic area served by the board or entity. Provides that a member who ceases to be a resident of the geographic area served by the board or entity is considered to have resigned as a member of the board or entity, and the vacancy is filled as specified by ordinance.

Effective: July 1, 2018.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning labor and safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

8	(b) As used in this section, "contractor board" means a board
9	or other entity that issues a license, registration, or certificate

12	(c) A member of a contractor board must be:
13	(1) at least eighteen (18) years of age; and
14	(2) except for an ex-officio member, a resident of the
15	geographic area served by the contractor board.
16	(d) This subsection does not apply to an ex-officio member of a
17	contractor board. A member of a contractor board who ceases to
