DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-6-14; IC 4-21.5-3-4; IC 12-15-11-2.5; IC 25-0.5; IC 25-1; IC 33-23-8-3; IC 34-52-2-1.

Synopsis: Professions and occupations. Reorganization of certain licensing provisions. Provides for the reorganization of 12 Indiana Code sections containing frequently amended lists of professions and entities subject to professional licensing under IC 25-1. Makes no substantive change. Transfers the lists contained in each of these sections to corresponding chapters in a new IC 25 article. Sets forth the boilerplate language to be used when amending or adding a provision under the new structure. Updates affected internal references and cross-references. Removes obsolete references to entities not licensed by the professional licensing agency. Makes technical corrections. (The introduced version of this bill was prepared by the code revision commission.)

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning professions and occupations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

 21 (ii) pipes, pumps, and appurtenant facilities, devices, or
 22 structures that are part of a public water system (as defined

 24 a storage or treatment facility or to distribute water to the
 25 users of the public water system;
 26 where a federal, state, or local governmental body has given or
 27 will give public notice and has provided or will provide an

1 (F) IC 13-20-4 for a person to operate a municipal waste
2 collection and transportation vehicle.

3 (b) When an agency issues an order described by subsection (a), the
4 agency shall give a written notice of the order to the following persons:

5 (1) Each person to whom the order is specifically directed.

6 (2) Each person to whom a law requires notice to be given.

7 A person who is entitled to notice under this subsection is not a party
8 to any proceeding resulting from the grant of a petition for review
9 under section 7 of this chapter unless the person is designated as a
10 party on the record of the proceeding.

11 (c) The notice must include the following:

12 (1) A brief description of the order.

13 (2) A brief explanation of the available procedures and the time
14 limit for seeking administrative review of the order under section
15 7 of this chapter.

16 (3) Any information required by law.

17 (d) An order under this section is effective when it is served.
18 However, if a timely and sufficient application has been made for
19 renewal of a license described by subsection (a)(3) and review is
20 granted under section 7 of this chapter, the existing license does not
21 expire until the agency has disposed of the proceeding under this
22 chapter concerning the renewal, unless a statute other than this article
23 provides otherwise. This subsection does not preclude an agency from
24 issuing under IC 4-21.5-4 an emergency or other temporary order with
25 respect to the license.

26 (e) If a petition for review of an order described in subsection (a) is
27 filed within the period set by section 7 of this chapter and a petition for
28 stay of effectiveness of the order is filed by a party or another person
29 who has a pending petition for intervention in the proceeding, an
30 administrative law judge shall, as soon as practicable, conduct a
31 preliminary hearing to determine whether the order should be stayed in
32 whole or in part. The burden of proof in the preliminary hearing is on
33 the person seeking the stay. The administrative law judge may stay the
34 order in whole or in part. The order concerning the stay may be issued
35 after an order described in subsection (a) becomes effective. The
36 resulting order concerning the stay shall be served on the parties and
37 any person who has a pending petition for intervention in the
38 proceeding. It must include a statement of the facts and law on which
39 it is based.

7 heirs, executors, administrators, successors, and assignees,
8 jointly and severally, as surety.
- 9 (4) The surety bond must provide the surety's name, street address
10 or post office box number, city, state, and ZIP code.
- 11 (5) The surety bond must provide that the surety is liable under
12 the surety bond for a duplicate, erroneous, or false Medicaid
13 claim paid by the office or its fiscal agent to the transportation
14 provider during the term of the surety bond.
- 15 (6) The surety bond must provide that the bond may not be void
16 on a first recovery, but that suits may be instituted until the
17 penalty is exhausted.
- 18 (7) The surety bond must guarantee that the surety will, not later
19 than thirty (30) days after the surety receives written notice from
20 the office containing sufficient evidence to establish the surety's
21 liability under the surety bond as described in subdivision (5), pay
22 to the office the following amounts, not to exceed the full amount
23 of the surety bond:
24 (A) The amount of the duplicate, erroneous, or false claim that
25 was previously paid by the office or its fiscal agent to the
26 transportation provider, plus accrued interest.
27 (B) An assessment imposed under IC 12-15-22 by the office
28 on the transportation provider.
- 29 (8) The surety bond must provide that if the transportation
30 provider's provider agreement is not renewed or is terminated, the
31 surety bond submitted by the transportation provider remains in
32 effect until the last day of the surety bond coverage period and the
33 surety remains liable for a duplicate, erroneous, or false claim
34 paid by the office or its fiscal agent to the transportation provider
35 during the term of the surety bond.
- 36 (9) The surety bond must provide that actions under the surety
37 bond may be brought by the office or the attorney general.
- 38 (e) The office may revoke or deny a provider agreement for a
39 transportation provider's failure to comply with this section.
- 40 (f) The office may revoke a provider agreement if a transportation
41 provider cancels a surety bond required by this section.
- 42 (g) The office or its designee may, at any time, require a



1 transportation provider to demonstrate compliance with this section.

2 (h) If:

3 (1) a surety has paid the office for a liability incurred under a
4 surety bond under this section; and

5 (2) the transportation provider is subsequently successful in
6 appealing the determination of liability;

7 the office shall, upon completion of the appellate process, refund the
8 surety or the transportation provider the full amount paid for the
9 liability.
