

SENATE BILL No. 68

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 31-11-1-1.

Synopsis: Marriage. Repeals statutory text that restricts a marriage to be between only a male and a female. Repeals statutory text that provides that a marriage between persons of the same gender is void in Indiana.

Effective: June 25, 2014 (retroactive).

SENATE BILL No. 68

A BILL FOR AN ACT to repeal a provision of the Indiana Code concerning family law and juvenile law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 31-11-1-1 IS REPEALED [EFFECTIVE JUNE 25,
2 2014 (RETROACTIVE)]. ~~Sec. 1. (a) Only a female may marry a male.~~
3 ~~Only a male may marry a female.~~
4 (b) A marriage between persons of the same gender is void in
5 Indiana even if the marriage is lawful in the place where it is
6 solemnized.
7 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
