SENATE ENROLLED ACT No. 72

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 20-19-3-30 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023]: Sec. 30. (a) Not later than October 1, 2023, each public elementary school, including a charter school, and state accredited nonpublic elementary school shall provide to the department the following information:

- (1) Whether the school provides instruction on cursive writing to students of the school.
- (2) If the school provides cursive writing instruction, the grade level of students to whom the instruction is provided.
- (b) Not later than December 1, 2023, the department shall:
 - (1) prepare a report regarding the information that the department receives under subsection (a); and
 - (2) submit the report described in subdivision (1) to the legislative council in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6.
- (c) This section expires January 1, 2024.
