

SENATE BILL No. 89

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-3-27-9.

Synopsis: Artisan distillery liquor distribution. Provides that an artisan distiller may sell liquor to a retailer or dealer that is located within 30 miles of the artisan distiller's distillery.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-3-27-9, AS AMENDED BY P.L.159-2014,
2 SECTION 11, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 9. **(a) An artisan distiller may sell liquor to a
4 retailer or dealer that is located within thirty (30) miles of the
5 artisan distiller's distillery.**

6 ~~(a)~~ **(b) Except as provided in subsection (a),** an artisan distiller
7 may not sell liquor to a retailer or dealer.

8 ~~(b)~~ **(c) An artisan distiller who knowingly or intentionally violates**
9 **this section commits a Class B misdemeanor.**
