SENATE BILL No. 142

DIGEST OF SB 142 (Updated January 22, 2014 1:50 pm - DI 104)

Citations Affected: IC 12-8; IC 12-15.

Synopsis: Administration of Medicaid. Designates the office of the secretary of family and social services as the single state agency for the administration of the Medicaid program and removes the designation from the office of Medicaid policy and planning. Specifies that the office of Medicaid policy and planning develops and coordinates Medicaid policy for Indiana under the direction of the secretary of family and social services. Repeals provisions referring to the office of Medicaid policy and planning as the single state agency for administering Medicaid.

Effective: Upon passage; July 1, 2014.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

COMMITTEE REPORT

Madam President: The Senate Committee on Health and Provider Services, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 142, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Replace the effective dates in SECTIONS 1 through 4 with "[EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]".

Page 1, delete lines 11 through 13, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 3. IC 12-8-6.5-4, AS ADDED BY P.L.160-2012, SECTION 18, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 4. **Under the direction of the secretary**, the office shall develop and coordinate Medicaid policy for the state."

Page 2, after line 1, begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 5. IC 12-15-13-0.4, AS ADDED BY P.L.117-2008, SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 0.4. As used in this chapter, "office" includes the following:

- (1) The office of ~~Medicaid policy and planning~~; **the secretary of family and social services.**
- (2) A managed care organization that has contracted with the office of Medicaid policy and planning under this article.
- (3) A person that has contracted with a managed care organization described in subdivision (2).

SECTION 6. **An emergency is declared for this act.**"

Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
