DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-8; IC 12-15-1-1.

Synopsis: Administration of Medicaid. Designates the office of the secretary of family and social services as the single state agency for the administration of the Medicaid program and removes the designation from the office of Medicaid policy and planning. Repeals provisions referring to the office of Medicaid policy and planning as the single state agency for administering, developing, and coordinating Medicaid.

Effective: July 1, 2014.
