SENATE BILL No. 144

DIGEST OF SB 144 (Updated February 11, 2021 3:48 pm - DI 140)

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-3.

Synopsis: Bulk wine purchasing limitations. Provides that the bulk wine purchasing limits for farm wineries apply only to wine sold directly to a consumer in Indiana, and that no limit is imposed on the amount of bulk wine that may be used in producing wine sold through a wholesaler or sold outside of Indiana.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

SENATE BILL No. 144

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-3-12-7 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 7. (a) Except as
3 provided in ~~subsection~~ **subsections (b) and (c)**, a farm winery may
4 purchase annually a quantity of bulk wine that does not exceed the
5 greater of the following:
6 (1) Five thousand five hundred (5,500) gallons.
7 (2) Fifty percent (50%) of the quantity of wine produced by
8 fermentation by the winery during the previous year.
9 (b) This subsection applies to a farm winery that suffers a loss of
10 wine inventory due to natural or manmade disaster. If the farm winery
11 documents the inventory loss and obtains permission from the
12 commission, the winery may purchase a quantity of bulk wine not
13 greater than the sum of the following:
14 (1) The quantity of the winery's wine inventory loss.
15 (2) The quantity of bulk wine that may be purchased by the farm
16 winery annually under subsection (a).
17 **(c) The limits in subsections (a) and (b) apply only to wine sold**
