## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 16-34-1-2.

**Synopsis:** Prohibited government abortion assistance. Prohibits the state or a political subdivision of the state from assisting an individual in seeking or obtaining an abortion. Allows for the state or a political subdivision to inform an individual of alternatives to an abortion.

Effective: July 1, 2025.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
