DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-7-18-8.

Synopsis: Housing authority commissioner compensation. Increases the per diem paid to a commissioner of a housing authority from \$25 to \$100.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

SENATE BILL No. 172

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 36-7-18-8 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 8. A commissioner of
3 a housing authority is entitled to:
4 (1) a per diem allowance of ~~twenty-five dollars (\$25)~~ **one**
5 **hundred dollars (\$100)** for attending a meeting of the authority;
6 and
7 (2) reimbursement for necessary expenses, including traveling
8 expenses, incurred in the discharge of the commissioner's duties.
