DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-9-5-5.

Synopsis: Prohibition of free or reduced fares on election day. Prohibits certain free or reduced public transportation fares on election day.

Effective: July 1, 2024.

SENATE BILL No. 187

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-9-5-5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2024]: **Sec. 5. A public transportation agency shall not**
4 **implement free or reduced fares on a general, primary, or**
5 **municipal election day.**
