DIGEST OF SB 212 (Updated February 23, 2023 2:37 pm - DI 152)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Witness protection pilot programs. Urges the legislative council to assign the topic of witness protection and assistance pilot programs in Lake County, Marion County, and Vanderburgh County to the appropriate interim study committee.

Effective: July 1, 2023.

SENATE BILL No. 212

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023] (a) The legislative
council is urged to assign to the appropriate interim study
committee the task of studying a witness protection pilot program
in Lake County, Marion County, and Vanderburgh County to
provide protection for victims of and witnesses to crime, with
particular emphasis on gang related crimes and crimes of domestic
violence.

(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2024.



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COMMITTEE REPORT

Delete the title and insert the following:

Page 1, delete lines 1 through 17.

Delete page 2.

Page 3, delete lines 1 through 14.

Page 3, line 15, delete "may each establish a three (3) year".

Page 3, line 15, beginning with "witness" begin a new paragraph and insert:

"SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2023] (a) The legislative council is urged to assign to the appropriate interim study committee the task of studying a".

Page 3, line 16, after "program" insert "in Marion County and in Vanderburgh County".

Page 3, between lines 18 and 19, begin a new paragraph and insert: "(b) This SECTION expires July 1, 2024.".

Page 3, delete lines 19 through 42.

Delete page 4.

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
