

SENATE BILL No. 248

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-3-22-5.

Synopsis: Package liquor store permit quota. Changes the quota for package liquor store permits to one permit for every 12,000 (instead of 8,000) persons in a city or town.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

SENATE BILL No. 248

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-3-22-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 5. (a) The commission
3 may issue only one (1) package liquor store dealer's permit in an
4 incorporated city or town for each ~~eight thousand (8,000)~~ **twelve**
5 **thousand (12,000)** persons, or fraction thereof, within the incorporated
6 city or town.
7 (b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the commission may renew a
8 package liquor store dealer's permit for an applicant who:
9 (1) held a permit before July 1, ~~1997~~; **2021**; and
10 (2) does not qualify for a permit under the quota requirements of
11 subsection (a).
