A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning courts and court officers.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

9	(B) the clerk is required to collect a small claims costs fee
10	under IC 33-37-4-6; or
11	(3) probate action in which the clerk is required to collect a
12	probate costs fee under IC 33-37-4-7(a);
13	the clerk shall, before July 1, 2022, collect a pro bono legal services fee
14	of one dollar (\$1). three dollars (\$3).
