PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 2017 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

SENATE ENROLLED ACT No. 264

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 16-18-2-196.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS** [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018]: **Sec. 196.5. "Kit", for purposes of IC 16-21-8-1.8, has the meaning set forth in IC 16-21-8-1.8(a).**

SECTION 2. IC 16-18-2-344 IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018]: Sec. 344. "Superintendent":

(1) **for purposes of IC 16-21-8-1.8, has the meaning set forth in IC 10-11-1-4; and**

(2) for purposes of IC 16-36-3, has the meaning set forth in IC 12-7-2-188(3).

SECTION 3. IC 16-21-8-1.8 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS** [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2018]: **Sec. 1.8. (a) As used in this section, "kit" means the standard medical forensic examination kit for victims of a sex crime developed by the state police department under IC 10-11-2-33(a).**

(b) **The statewide sexual assault response team advisory council shall prepare, not later than December 1, 2018, a report regarding the following issues:**

(1) **The feasibility of creating a tracking system to monitor the:**

(A) **number; and**

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**(B) testing status;
of kits submitted for testing.**

(2) The resources and training needed to create, manage, and maintain the tracking system described in subdivision (1).

(3) The amount of money needed to create, manage, and maintain the tracking system described in subdivision (1).

(4) Possible sources of funding for:

(A) the tracking system described in subdivision (1); and

(B) all associated expenses related to the creation, management, and maintenance of the tracking system described in subdivision (1).

(5) A recommendation concerning the identity of the supervising agency or entity responsible for creating, operating, managing, and maintaining the tracking system described in subdivision (1).

(c) The report described in subsection (b) must be presented to the legislative council in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6.

(d) This section expires December 31, 2019.
