SENATE BILL No. 294**

DIGEST OF SB 294 (Updated February 24, 2016 11:24 am - DI 107)

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-3.

Synopsis: Sale of carryout at Indianapolis 500 Race. Provides that the holder of a three-way permit that is issued to a premises located at a facility used in connection with the operation of a paved track more than two miles in length may sell sealed bottles of liquor or wine for consumption off the licensed premises: (1) from one or more locations on the premises; and (2) on the date of the Indianapolis 500 Race in the 2016 calendar year from 7 a.m., prevailing local time, to 7 p.m., prevailing local time. Requires the: (1) holder of the three-way permit to disclose to the alcohol and tobacco commission, at least 14 days before the Indianapolis 500 Race, that the holder intends to sell the bottles; and (2) bottles to be decorative bottles commemorating the one hundredth anniversary of the Indianapolis 500 Race.

Effective: Upon passage.

ENGROSSED SENATE BILL No. 294

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-3-9-13 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 13. (a) This section applies to the holder of**
4 **a three-way permit that is issued for a premises described in**
5 **IC 7.1-3-1-14(c)(2).**
6 **(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this title or rule**
7 **adopted by the commission and subject to subsections (c) and (d),**
8 **the holder of a three-way permit may sell sealed bottles of liquor**
9 **or wine for consumption off the licensed premises:**
10 **(1) from one (1) or more locations on a premises described in**
11 **IC 7.1-3-1-14(c)(2); and**
12 **(2) on the date of the Indianapolis 500 Race in the 2016**
13 **calendar year from 7 a.m., prevailing local time, to 7 p.m.,**
14 **prevailing local time.**
15 **(c) The holder of a three-way permit described under subsection**
16 **(b) must disclose to the commission, at least fourteen (14) days**
17 **before the date of the Indianapolis 500 Race, that the holder**

1 **intends to sell bottles of liquor or wine under this section.**
2 **(d) The bottles of liquor or wine described in subsection (b)**
3 **must be decorative bottles commemorating the one hundredth**
4 **anniversary of the Indianapolis 500 Race.**
5 **(e) This section expires January 1, 2017.**
6 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**
