DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Regulation of political signs. Provides that an ordinance or a regulation of a political subdivision relating to the number or size of political signs is unenforceable beginning 45 days before an election and ending at the beginning of the sixth day after the election.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
