

SENATE BILL No. 383

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-19-7-2; IC 9-21-10-3.

Synopsis: Motorcycle equipment. Provides that a motorcycle may be equipped with a steering wheel. (Current law provides that a motorcycle may be equipped only with handlebars for purposes of steering and control.) Makes a conforming change.

Effective: Upon passage.

SENATE BILL No. 383

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 9-19-7-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.221-2014,
2 SECTION 35, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 2. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b), a
4 motorcycle or motor driven cycle operated on the streets or highways
5 by a resident of Indiana must meet the following requirements:
6 (1) Be equipped with:
7 (A) handlebars that rise not higher than the shoulders of the
8 driver when the driver is seated in the driver's seat or saddle;
9 or
10 (B) a steering wheel.
11 (2) Be equipped with brakes in good working order on both front
12 and rear wheels.
13 (3) Be equipped with footrests or pegs for both operator and
14 passenger.
15 (4) Be equipped with lamps and reflectors meeting the standards
16 of the United States Department of Transportation.



1 (b) A motorcycle or motor driven cycle manufactured before
2 January 1, 1956, is not required to be equipped with lamps and other
3 illuminating devices under subsection (a) if the motorcycle or motor
4 driven cycle is not operated at the times when lighted head lamps and
5 other illuminating devices are required under IC 9-21-7-2.

6 SECTION 2. IC 9-21-10-3, AS AMENDED BY P.L.221-2014,
7 SECTION 46, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
8 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 3. A person who operates a motorcycle or
9 motor driven cycle may not carry a package, bundle, or other article
10 that prevents the person from keeping both hands on the handlebars or
11 **steering wheel.**

12 SECTION 3. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
