

SENATE BILL No. 395

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 35-43-5-23.

Synopsis: Rental lease application deception. Provides that a person who knowingly or intentionally omits a previous eviction on a rental application commits rental application deception, a Class C misdemeanor.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning criminal law and procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 35-43-5-23 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2017]: **Sec. 23. A person who knowingly or intentionally omits a**
4 **previous eviction in an application for a rental lease commits rental**
5 **application deception, a Class C misdemeanor.**
