

SENATE BILL No. 492

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-1-8.5-2.

Synopsis: Restricted address program. Adds: (1) public safety telecommunicators; and (2) 911 emergency call dispatch center administrators; to the persons who may restrict access to their home address on a local government's public property data base website.

Effective: July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

2 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2025]: Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "covered person"

5 (1) A judge.
6 (2) A law enforcement officer.
7 (3) An address confidentiality program participant.
8 (4) A public official.
9 (5) The surviving spouse of a person described in subdivision (2),
10 if the person was killed in the line of duty.
11 (6) An employee of the department of child services.
12 (7) A current or former probation officer.
13 (8) A current or former community corrections officer.
14 (9) A regular, paid firefighter or a volunteer firefighter (as defined
15 in IC 36-8-12-2).
16 **(10) A public safety telecommunicator (as defined in**
