1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION to allow the Senate and
2 the House of Representatives of the 124th Indiana General
3 Assembly to adjourn and recess separately throughout the First
4 Regular Session for periods in excess of three (3) consecutive
5 days as the need, in the judgment of the President Pro Tempore
6 of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
7 respectively, may arise.

8 *Whereas, The Indiana Senate and the House of*
9 *Representatives met for the purpose of organization of each*
10 *house and to conduct the public business of the people of the*
11 *State of Indiana;*

12 *Whereas, The Senate and the House of Representatives*
13 *shall operate on their own respective schedules, having been*
14 *separated from each other pursuant to IC 2-2.1-1-2;*

15 *Whereas, During the consideration of legislative business,*
16 *each house may, in the respective judgment of the President*
17 *Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of*
18 *Representatives, deem it necessary to adjourn and recess for*
19 *periods in excess of three (3) consecutive days and to operate*
20 *on a schedule different from the other house;*

21 *Whereas, Article 4, Section 10 of the Constitution of the*
22 *State of Indiana states that neither house shall, without the*
23 *consent of the other, adjourn for more than three (3)*
24 *consecutive days;*

25 *Whereas, Each house desires to consent to any*



1 *adjournment or recess by the other house that might last more*
2 *than three (3) days during the First Regular Session of the*
3 *124th General Assembly; and*

4 *Whereas, The Senate and the House of Representatives*
5 *intend to recess after November 19, 2024, and meet again on*
6 *January 8, 2025, to conduct legislative business: Therefore,*

7 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*
8 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*
9 *concurring:*

10 SECTION 1. That each House of the 124th Indiana General
11 Assembly hereby consents to any adjournment or recess of the
12 other House during the First Regular Session of the 124th
13 General Assembly for a period in excess of three (3) days,
14 where such recess or adjournment is approved, in the case of
15 the Senate, by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, or, in
16 the case of the House of Representatives, by the Speaker of the
17 House of Representatives.

18 SECTION 2. The Secretary of the Senate is hereby directed
19 to inform the House of Representatives of the passage of the
20 Resolution.
