1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Indiana
2 Department of Transportation to rename the bridge at State
3 Road 28 (Walnut Avenue) in Frankfort the "Staff Sergeant
4 Jamie Jarboe Bridge".

5 *Whereas, Staff Sergeant Jamie Jarboe died March 21, 2012,*
6 *in Topeka, Kansas, from wounds suffered on April 10, 2011, in*
7 *Kandahar province, Afghanistan, when enemy forces attacked*
8 *his unit with small-arms fire;*

9 *Whereas, Staff Sergeant Jamie Jarboe had been deployed to*
10 *Afghanistan only months before he was shot in the neck, an*
11 *injury that left him a quadriplegic;*

12 *Whereas, Twenty-seven-year-old Staff Sergeant Jamie Jarboe*
13 *underwent more than 100 surgeries in the 12 months before he*
14 *succumbed to his injuries;*

15 *Whereas, A 2003 graduate of Frankfort High School, Staff*
16 *Sergeant Jarboe was a member of the 4th Squadron, 4th*
17 *Cavalry Regiment, 1st Heavy Brigade Combat Team of the 1st*
18 *Infantry Division from Fort Riley known as the Pale Riders;*

19 *Whereas, Staff Sergeant Jarboe joined the Indiana National*
20 *Guard in 2005 and attended basic and advanced individual*
21 *training at Fort Sill, Oklahoma;*

22 *Whereas, His military assignments included B Battery, 1st*
23 *Battalion, 320 Field Artillery at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, and*
24 *Troop A, 4th Squadron, 4th Cavalry, 1st Heavy Brigade*
25 *Combat Team;*



1 *Whereas, Staff Sergeant Jarboe's dedication and devotion to*
2 *service was recognized with the Bronze Star Medal, the Purple*
3 *Heart, the Army Commendation Medal (awarded three times),*
4 *the Army Achievement Medal, the Good Conduct Medal*
5 *(awarded twice), the National Defense Service Medal, the*
6 *Afghanistan Campaign Medal (1CS), the Iraq Campaign Medal*
7 *(3CS), the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, the Armed*
8 *Forces Reserve Medal (M Device), the NCO Professional*
9 *Development Ribbon, the Army Service Ribbon, the Overseas*
10 *Service Ribbon, the NATO Medal, the Combat Action Badge,*
11 *the Air Assault Badge, and the Expert Marksmanship Badge*
12 *(Rifle);*

13 *Whereas, A soldier's soldier, Staff Sergeant Jamie Jarboe*
14 *dedicated his life to his country and his family; and*

15 *Whereas, Throughout history, brave individuals like Staff*
16 *Sergeant Jamie Jarboe have made the ultimate sacrifice in*
17 *defense of freedom throughout the world; without individuals*
18 *like Staff Sergeant Jarboe, freedom could not survive:*
19 *Therefore,*

20 *Be it resolved by the Senate*
21 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
22 *the House of Representatives concurring:*

23 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly urges the
24 Indiana Department of Transportation to rename the bridge at
25 State Road 28 (Walnut Avenue) in Frankfort the "Staff Sergeant
26 Jamie Jarboe Bridge".

27 SECTION 2. That copies of this resolution be transmitted by
28 the Secretary of the Senate to the family of Staff Sergeant Jamie
29 Jarboe and the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of
30 Transportation.
