1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the late
2	Governor Joe Kernan and urging the Indiana Department of
3	Administration to place a memorial bust of Governor Kernan
4	within the State Capitol.
5	Whereas, Governor Joe Kernan was raised in South Bend,
6	Indiana, attending St. Joseph High School before graduating
7	from the University of Notre Dame with a degree in
8	Government in 1968;
9	Whereas, In 1969 Governor Kernan joined the United
10	States Navy where he served as a Naval Flight Officer, serving
11	on the aircraft carrier U.S.S. Kitty Hawk, and flying over 26
12	reconnaissance missions over Laos and North Vietnam during
13	the Vietnam War;
14	Whereas, Governor Kernan's aircraft was shot down by
15	enemy forces on May 7, 1972, and he was imprisoned in Hanoi,
16	North Vietnam, until March 27, 1973;
17	Whereas, For his service, a grateful nation awarded
18	Governor Kernan with the Distinguished Flying Cross, two
19	Purple Hearts, the Air Medal, and the Navy Commendation
20	Medal;
21	Whereas, While serving in the U.S. Naval Reserves, Kernan
22	began working in local government, serving as controller of
23	South Bend from 1980-1984 before being elected mayor of
24	South Bend in 1987, 1991, and 1995, when he won with more

1	than 82% of the vote;
2	Whereas, In 1996, Kernan was elected Lieutenant
3	Governor in partnership with Governor Frank O'Bannon and
4	the two were re-elected by Hoosiers in 2000;
5	Whereas, During his term as Lt. Governor, Kernan servea
6	as President of the Indiana Senate, the director of the Indiana
7	Department of Commerce, and as Commissioner of
8	Agriculture;
9	Whereas, Upon the death of Governor Frank O'Bannon,
10	Kernan assumed the position to become the 48th Governor of
11	Indiana;
12	Whereas, During his time in office, Governor Kernan
13	appointed Kathy Davis as the first female Lieutenant Governor,
14	launched "Opportunity Indiana" to increase opportunities for
15	Indiana business, promoted full-day kindergarten and the
16	state's community college system, created the Hoosier Health
17	Plan, supported the I-69 expansion, and was the first governor
18	in 48 years to spare the life of an inmate on death row by
19	commuting the sentence to life in prison without parole;
20	Whereas, Following the election of 2004, Governor Kernan
21	returned to South Bend where he taught at the University of
22	Notre Dame and became involved in various business and
23	community affairs, including the effort to keep the minor league
24	baseball team, the Silver Hawks, in South Bend;
25	Whereas, Governor Kernan passed away in his beloved
26	South Bend, Indiana on July 29, 2020;
27	Whereas, The IAC Foundation was formed in 1983 as an
28	adjunct to the Indianapolis Athletic Club and while the Athletic
29	Club closed in 2004, the Foundation has continued its
30	charitable operations; and
31	Whereas, The IAC Foundation wishes to honor the memory
32	of Governor Kernan, a proud Irish American during the 2023



1	St. Patrick's Day events in Indianapolis and as part of this
2	recognition, the IAC Foundation has commissioned a bronze
3	bust of Governor Kernan, created by noted Indianapolis
4	sculptor Ryan Feeney and financed with private contributions
5	to the IAC Foundation: Therefore,
6	Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly
7	of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives

SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly honors the life and memory of Joe Kernan, a man of noble distinction.

SECTION 2. That the Indiana General Assembly urges the Indiana Department of Administration to place the bronze bust of Governor Kernan within the State Capitol for permanent display in honor of Governor Kernan's selfless service to the state of Indiana and the United States of America.
