1           A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the legislative  
2 council to assign to the interim study committee on  
3 Government the task of reviewing the statutes that govern  
4 contracting procedures within the Indiana Department of  
5 Transportation.

6           *Whereas, The Indiana General Assembly recognizes that the*  
7 *Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) is one of the*  
8 *largest state agencies in Indiana with approximately 3,500*  
9 *employees;*

10           *Whereas, INDOT's mission is to "...plan, build, maintain, and*  
11 *operate a superior transportation system enhancing safety,*  
12 *mobility, and economic growth" while it maintains more than*  
13 *11,000 centerline miles and nearly 6,000 bridges across the*  
14 *state;*

15           *Whereas, It is the responsibility of the Indiana General*  
16 *Assembly to review, revise, and consolidate statutes as*  
17 *necessary to promote the smooth operation of state*  
18 *government;*

19           *Whereas, The Indiana General Assembly urges the legislative*  
20 *council to assign to the interim study committee on government*  
21 *the task of reviewing the statutes that govern contracting*  
22 *procedures within the Indiana Department of Transportation;*  
23 *and*

24           *Whereas, The legislative council is urged to incorporate the*  
25 *task into the study committee's ongoing mandate from the 2018*  
26 *legislative council Resolution 18-02, SECTION 4(8)(B),*



1     *requiring the study committee to "consolidate and revise*  
2     *statutes governing state and local governmental public works*  
3     *projects...": Therefore,*

4                     *Be it resolved by the Senate*  
5                     *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*  
6                     *the House of Representatives concurring:*

7             SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly urges the  
8     legislative council to assign to the interim study committee on
