8 *Whereas, Reserve Deputy Sheriff James Driver sacrificed*
9 *his life while responding to a vehicle accident on March 29,*
10 *2021;*

11 *Whereas, Reserve Deputy Sheriff James Driver was devoted*
12 *to the people of Monroe County, spending many of his days off*
13 *from his regular occupation to serve as Reserve Deputy;*

14 *Whereas, Reserve Deputy Sheriff James Driver was*
15 *working toward becoming a Deputy after obtaining American*
16 *citizenship;*

17 *Whereas, Reserve Deputy Sheriff James Driver was highly*
18 *regarded and beloved by the Monroe County Sheriff's Office*
19 *and community;*

20 *Whereas, Reserve Deputy Sheriff James Driver is survived*
21 *by his wife and three children; and*

22 *Whereas, It is appropriate that the portion of Interstate 69*
23 *at Exit 120 in Monroe County commemorate Reserve Deputy*
