5	Whereas, Dr. Jennifer Sullivan announced her departure
6	from the FSSA and the Indiana Department of Health in June
7	2021;
8	Whereas, Dr. Sullivan was appointed FSSA Secretary in
9	January 2017 and immediately began tackling numerous issues
10	impacting the health and quality of life for Hoosiers in Indiana;
11	Whereas, During Dr. Sullivan's tenure, she accomplished
12	many goals, including expanding pre-kindergarten services
13	statewide, achieving the lowest infant mortality rate in state
14	history, creating the only comprehensive human services
15	state/academic partnership in the country, implementing
16	Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program food delivery and
17	emergency food benefits for children during the COVID-19
18	pandemic, and extending the Healthy Indiana Plan to continue
19	health coverage for over 572,000 low-income adults;
20	Whereas, During her tenure as Deputy State Health
21	Commissioner, Dr. Sullivan led the Indiana Department of
22	Health in implementing the first needle exchange program in
23	state history, serving as the medical incident command leader
24	during the Scott County HIV response, and directing the

implementation of a statewide bystander naloxone program;

1	Whereas, Dr. Sullivan also served as an emergency
2	medicine physician at Riley Hospital for Children for more
3	than 20 years;
4	Whereas, For her accomplishments in improving Hoosier
5	health, the American Public Human Services Association
6	recognized her with the Jerry W. Friedman Health and Human
7	Services Impact Award in 2019;
8	Whereas, Dr. Sullivan has held a number of significant
9	academic positions as the Division Chief and Residency
10	Program Director for Pediatric Emergency Medicine at the
11	Indiana University School of Medicine, Professor of Clinical
12	Emergency Medicine and Pediatrics at the Indiana University
13	School of Medicine, and Adjunct Professor of Health Policy
14	and Management at the Indiana University Richard M.
15	Fairbanks School of Public Health;
16	Whereas, Dr. Sullivan earned her medical degree from the
17	Indiana University School of Medicine and was board certified
18	in emergency medicine and pediatrics;
19	Whereas, Dr. Sullivan earned her Master's Degree in
20	Public Health at the Indiana University Richard M. Fairbanks
21	School of Public Health and her undergraduate degree from the
22	University of Houston Honors College; and
23	Whereas, Following her position as FSSA Secretary, Dr.
24	Sullivan assumed a position as Senior Vice President of
25	Strategic Operations at Atrium Health and an academic
26	position with Wake Forest School of Medicine: Therefore,
