2 Inc. for 100 years of operation in the State of Indiana.

3 *Whereas, Cummins, Inc. was founded in 1919 in*
4 *Columbus, Indiana as an unlikely partnership between local*
5 *banker W.G. Irwin and his chauffeur and inventor Clessie*
6 *Cummins;*

7 *Whereas, As one of 200 companies with a diesel license,*
8 *Cummins took the available technology and transformed diesel*
9 *into a reliable power source for everyday use;*

10 *Whereas, Cummins is a global technology leader with*
11 *clean and reliable diesel, natural gas, hybrid, and electric*
12 *products in both on-highway and off-highway markets;*

13 *Whereas, People's lives are touched by Cummins every*
14 *day. From transporting children to school, to delivering goods*
15 *to homes and offices, to keeping power running at hospitals and*
16 *universities, Cummins' products make life easier and more*
17 *comfortable;*

18 *Whereas, Cummins has operated in the State of Indiana*
19 *since 1919, with Columbus continuing to serve as the global*
20 *headquarters for the Fortune 150 company that now operates*
21 *in 190 countries and employs more than 62,000 people*
22 *worldwide, with more than 10,000 employees in Indiana alone;*

23 *Whereas, During its first 100 years, Cummins prospered by*



1 *continuing to improve heavy duty powertrains while constantly*
2 *working to reduce its products environmental impact and*
3 *emissions;*

4 *Whereas, During its next 100 years, Cummins, will succeed*
5 *by pursuing innovative new technologies such as hybrid,*
6 *battery electric, and fuel cell technologies;*

7 *Whereas, Cummins is committed to not only creating a*
8 *stronger company, but to ensuring the communities where it*
9 *operates are stronger and more vibrant because of the*
10 *Cummins presence; and*

11 *Whereas, Cummins is positioned to continue to be the*
12 *leading provider of a diverse portfolio of clean and reliable*
13 *power solutions for the next 100 years: Therefore,*

14 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*
15 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives*
16 *concurring:*
