8	Whereas, Since he joined the faculty, Professor Jegen has
9	taught in the areas of civil and criminal law, federal and state
10	taxation, business and estate planning, and philanthropy and
11	has given over 420 bar review tax lectures and 970 lectures to
12	other lawyers, professionals, representatives of Congress, and
13	agencies;
14	Whereas, For his expertise, Professor Jegen has been
15	appointed to the Commissioner's Advisory Committee by the
16	Commissioner of Internal Revenue; five different Indiana
17	governors have appointed Professor Jegen to numerous
18	committees, including the National Conference on Uniform
19	State Laws; and Professor Jegen has served as special counsel
20	to the Indiana Department of State Revenue and the Indiana
21	Governor's Commission on Medical Education;
22	Whereas, For his contributions to ERISA, President Gerald
23	Ford invited Professor Jegen to the signing of ERISA in the
