1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring Professor
2 Lawrence Jegen III on his accomplishments.

3 *Whereas, Professor Lawrence Jegen III began his career at*
4 *Indiana University, School of Law - Indianapolis in August*
5 *1962, and almost 52 years later, continues to educate and serve*
6 *the students and community of Indiana University Robert H.*
7 *McKinney School of Law;*

8 *Whereas, Since he joined the faculty, Professor Jegen has*
9 *taught in the areas of civil and criminal law, federal and state*
10 *taxation, business and estate planning, and philanthropy and*
11 *has given over 420 bar review tax lectures and 970 lectures to*
12 *other lawyers, professionals, representatives of Congress, and*
13 *agencies;*

14 *Whereas, For his expertise, Professor Jegen has been*
15 *appointed to the Commissioner's Advisory Committee by the*
16 *Commissioner of Internal Revenue; five different Indiana*
17 *governors have appointed Professor Jegen to numerous*
18 *committees, including the National Conference on Uniform*
19 *State Laws; and Professor Jegen has served as special counsel*
20 *to the Indiana Department of State Revenue and the Indiana*
21 *Governor's Commission on Medical Education;*

22 *Whereas, For his contributions to ERISA, President Gerald*
23 *Ford invited Professor Jegen to the signing of ERISA in the*



1 *Rose Garden at the White House; and*

2 *Whereas, As a recognition for his contributions, Professor*
3 *Jegen has been awarded the highest award granted by Indiana*
4 *University, the Thomas Hart Benton Mural Medallion, twice;*
5 *Indiana University's Most Outstanding Law Professor Award*
6 *six times; the Sagamore of the Wabash Award from three*
7 *different Indiana Governors; and a Presidential Citation from*
8 *the Indiana State Bar Association for his leadership in the*
9 *profession of law, among other accolades and awards:*
10 *Therefore,*

11 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly*
12 *of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:*

13 SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly recognizes and
14 congratulates Professor Lawrence Jegen III on his extensive
15 accomplishments, appointments, awards, and continued service to the
16 legal community.
