4	selected as one of the top 100 administrators in North
5	America by the Executive Educator;

7	Executive Publication as a Trendsetter, and Who's Who in
8	Black Indianapolis. Nate has also served on numerous not-
9	for-profit organization boards;

11	American Superintendent to accept the awesome

13	Pike Township. Nate is the first African-American
14	Superintendent who graduated from Indianapolis Public
