MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

| 3 | Whereas, Women are an essential part of the United States |
| 4 | military and the profession of arms, having served throughout |
| 5 | the history of the United States of America; |
| 6 | Whereas, Many women, unable to serve lawfully in the |
| 7 | profession of arms, provided critical support to the United |
| 8 | States Army during the American Revolutionary War as nurses, |
| 9 | seamstresses, and cooks; |
| 10 | Whereas, The U.S. Army reports that women did fight |
| 11 | alongside their husbands in combat or disguised themselves as |
| 12 | men in order to serve, and women took an active role providing |
| 13 | the military with intelligence on enemy troop movements |
| 14 | throughout the colonies and along the frontier; |
| 15 | Whereas, The U.S. Army reports that women served once |
| 16 | again during the Civil War in critical roles as nurses and aides |
| 17 | in addition to an estimated 400 women who secretly enlisted as |
| 18 | soldiers to fight in the Union or Confederate armies; |
| 19 | Whereas, The U.S. Army established a permanent Nurse |

| 1 | Corps in 1901, recognizing the skilled role of nurses in the |

| 3 | outbreak of typhoid fever, when an estimated 1,500 contract |
| 4 | nurses served in Army and Navy general hospitals and |
| 5 | throughout the Northern Hemisphere during the war effort; |
| 6 | Whereas, An estimated 25,000 women between the ages of |
| 7 | 21 and 69 served overseas during World War I, prompting |
| 8 | increased roles for women in the military in the Army, Navy, |
| 9 | and Marines as the United States' involvement in World War II |
| 10 | began in earnest; |
| 11 | Whereas, During World War II, more than 60,000 Army |
| 12 | nurses served around the world, with an estimated 140,000 |
| 13 | women serving in the U.S. Army and the Women's Army Corps; |
| 14 | Whereas, the U.S. Army reports that more than 1,000 |
| 15 | women flew aircraft for the Women Airforce Service Pilots, a |
| 16 | civilian women pilots organization, during that same period; |
| 17 | Whereas, The role of women in the United States military |
| 18 | and their voluntary service continued to grow over the decades, |
| 19 | especially in nursing, and an estimated 170,000 women served |
| 20 | on active duty by 1980 according to the Women in Military |
| 21 | Service Memorial Foundation; |
| 22 | Whereas, The United States, acknowledging the value and |
| 23 | strength of women in the military, offered females the |
| 24 | opportunity to serve in combat roles throughout the armed |
| 25 | forces in 2015; and |
| 26 | Whereas, Women today serve and fight alongside their |
| 27 | fellow soldiers, sailors, airmen, marines, and guardians on |
| 28 | behalf of the United States of America: Therefore, |
| 29 | Be it resolved by the Senate of the |
| 30 | General Assembly of the State of Indiana: |
