MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION memorializing the life of 2 Zachary Steven Eckert.

the world, and cheering on his beloved IU Hoosiers; and

Whereas, Because Zach's affable manner, sense of humor,
humility, compassion, and purpose touched so many people in
his short life -- especially the members of his extended Senate
