## MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

6	Whereas, Virtual currency is an electronic form of cash;
7	Whereas, Virtual currencies are bought and sold for other
8	currencies, services, and products;
9	Whereas, The use of virtual currencies in society has caught
10	the attention of governments around the world;
11	Whereas, Individuals and businesses that buy, sell, and store
12	virtual currencies are largely unregulated, raising concerns
13	about security, insolvency, theft, and hacking; and
14	Whereas, The Uniform Law Commission has drafted the
15	Uniform Regulation of Virtual Currency Businesses Act to
16	provide a statutory framework for the regulation of businesses
17	that engage in virtual currency business activity: Therefore,
18	Be it resolved by the Senate
19	of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:



SECTION 1. That the Legislative Council is urged to assign to an appropriate study committee the task of considering the enactment of the Uniform Regulation of Virtual Currency Businesses Act or other virtual currency regulation in the State of Indiana.
