MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the Governor to
2	proclaim September as Brain Aneurysm Awareness Month.
3	Whereas, A brain aneurysm, also referred to as a cerebral
4	aneurysm or intracranial aneurysm, is a weak bulging spot on
5	the wall of a brain artery;
6	Whereas, Although relatively uncommon, ruptured
7	aneurysms are very serious and usually associated with a high
8	mortality rate and disability;
9	Whereas, The blood flow within the artery pounds against
10	the thinned portion of the wall, and bulging spots form that
11	begin to swell outward;
12	Whereas, Pressure may cause this aneurysm to rupture,
13	allowing blood to escape into the space around the brain,
14	which usually requires advanced surgical treatment;
15	Whereas, Survivors of brain aneursyms face many
16	challenges on their road to recovery: Physical challenges,
17	emotional challenges, depression, and potential deficits;

1	Whereas, Only through knowledge and understanding will
2	we be better able to help survivors and ensure that all of their
3	rights are protected; and
4	Whereas, It is critical that we help raise awareness of brain
5	aneurysms, including methods of early detection and treatment:

8	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	awareness and better help survivors.
