7	demonstrations with faculty who include Indiana Supreme
8	Court justices; Court of Appeals and trial court judges;
9	members of the executive and legislative branches of Indiana
10	government; and prominent business and military leaders;
11	Whereas, One of the principal themes of LDA is: Leading
12	begins with the attitude of a servant leader - to serve first, and
13	out of service we are given the honor to lead; and
14	Whereas, February 16-17, 2016 marks the LDA session
