## SENATE RESOLUTION

## MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

A SENATE RESOLUTION congratulating Mr. Logan
 Wagner on his 2021 state championship title in wrestling.

Whereas, On February 20, 2021, Zionsville High School
Senior Logan Wagner won the state title in the 145-pound
weight class;

6 Whereas, Logan had previously been to the state finals 7 three times, placing third as a junior in 2020, sixth as a 8 sophomore in 2019, and eighth as a freshman in 2018;

Whereas, Through intense training and visualizing this win,
Logan was prepared and ready to become Zionsville's first ever
IHSAA state champion for individual wrestling;

Whereas, Logan entered the state finals with a 38-1 record,
and was ranked at number two in the 145-pound weight class;

Whereas, Logan successfully fended off all five of his
competitors during the state finals, beginning with Connor
Giles of Jeffersonville, then advancing to a match with Toby
Abbott of Cowan, then moving forward to the semifinals to face
off with Jaden Reynolds where Logan achieved a 3-2 win,

*finally facing off with Hayden Watson of Center Grove to determine 2021's 145-pound weight class wrestling state champion;*

Whereas, The match was thrilling, with Hayden getting a
takedown in the first and second periods, and jumping out to a
5-1 lead over Logan;

Whereas, Logan made a comeback, making an escape and
bringing it to 5-2, and then another a quick escape, making it
5-3;

10 Whereas, With twenty-two seconds left, Logan secured a 11 takedown, and with fifteen seconds left on the clock, Logan 12 clinched the match with 3 nearfall points, securing his victory 13 and ending the match 9-5;

Whereas, Logan's victory marks Zionsville's first individual 14 15 wrestling state champion, and it is fitting that a Wagner is Zionsville's first champion, as Logan comes from a long line of 16 Zionsville wrestlers, with his father an assistant coach for over 17 two decades at the school, his uncles Shane and Ryan both 18 four-time state qualifiers, his older brother Kody a fourth place 19 finisher in the state in 2018, and his younger brother Chase a 20 sectional champion and semi-state qualifier in 2021; and 21

Whereas, Wagner ended his career 143-22 for the Eagles
and will continue his wrestling and academic career at Marian
University next year, and he will continue to be an inspiration
and source of pride for Zionsville: Therefore,
