MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the legislative council
2 to assign to the appropriate study committee the topic of a

6 *Whereas, Across the United States, the national violent*
7 *crime rate increased by 3.3 percent in 2015 and 3.4 percent in*
8 *2016, with 2016 being the largest single-year increase in 25*
9 *years;*

10 *Whereas, The nationwide homicide rate has increased more*
11 *than 20 percent since 2014;*

12 *Whereas, In light of increased violence in schools and other*
13 *populated settings, it is imperative to have a thorough study to*
14 *develop comprehensive solutions to the problem: Therefore,*

15 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the*
16 *General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

17 SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to assign to the
