| Committees on Agriculture, Corrections and Criminal Law, |
| Ethics, Insurance and Financial Institutions, Natural    |

Whereas, Senator Steele boasts an extensive list of legislative initiatives he spearheaded during his time in the Senate, many of them regarding cracking down on crime, such as his five years of work rewriting Indiana's criminal code; two bills he authored that allows for the death penalty or life without parole for those who burn, torture, mutilate, or decapitate their victims; a bill he drafted that sets lifetime parole and ankle bracelets for repeat sex offenders; a bill he authored to create the sex and violent offender registry; and his

| 6  | the Lifetime Carry Permit Law;                                 |
| 7  | Whereas, Senator Steele helped pass the Veteran Funera         |
| 8  | Protection Bill, rewrote the Land Partition Law, and carried   |
| 9  | the original Unclaimed Property Bill;                          |
| 0  | Whereas, In addition to his elected service in the Senate,     |
| 1  | Senator Steele served previously from 1995-2002 in the Indiana |
| 2  | House of Representatives as the Republican Whip; is a member   |
| 3  | of the Bedford Lions Club, the Bedford Masonic Lodge #14, the  |
| 4  | Scottish Rite, the York Rite and the Shriners; the Lawrence    |
| 5  | County Bar Association, the Indiana State Bar Association, the |
| 6  | National Rifle Association, and the National Muzzle Loading    |
| 7  | Rifle Association;   |
| 8  | Whereas, Senator Steele has served on the boards for the       |
| 9  | First National Bank of Mitchell and the Lawrence County        |
| 20 | Sheriff Merit Board, and currently serves as the President of  |
| 21 | the Board of Directors for the Bedford City Plan Commission,   |
| 22 | Whereas, Senator Steele received his B.S. and J.D. from        |
| 23 | Indiana University, and has ran a successful and respected law |
| 24 | practice, Steele & Steele, LLC, in Bedford, Indiana since 1972 |
| 25 | when he joined his father's law practice;                      |
| 26 | Whereas, Senator Steele is married to his loving wife Sally,   |
| 27 | with whom he has four sons – Sean, Aaron, Rhett, and Gavin –   |
| 28 | all of whom have supported him for 20 years, in both his home  |

| 1  | better the lives of Hoosiers across the state will be greatly  |
