## **SENATE RESOLUTION**

## MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION to honor John R. Wooden for
2	taking a stand against segregation in collegiate basketball in
3	1947.
4	Whereas, In 1947 while coaching the Indiana State
5	Teacher's College Sycamores (Indiana State University) and
6	having a winning season, Coach Wooden turned down an
7	invitation to participate in the NAIB (NCAA) tournament;
8	Whereas, Clarence Walker, the only African-American
9	team member for the Sycamores would have had to stay at
10	home;
11	Whereas, Even though Walker rarely played, Wooden
12	wanted to take a stand against segregation in collegiate
13	basketball;
14	Whereas, In response to Wooden's decision, several other
15	schools began to decline the invitation in protest as well;
16	Whereas, In 1948 the NAIB decided to allow integrated
17	teams to play;

1	Whereas, On March 9, 1948 when Walker went into the
2	game during the first round of the tournament, it was the first
3	time a black player competed in the tournament;
4	Whereas, The following year three teams brought black
5	players to play in the tournament; and
6	Whereas, In 1950 City College of New York won both the
7	NIT and NCAA with two black starters: Therefore,
8	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
9	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
0	SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate recognizes John R. Wooden
1	for his stand against segregation in 1947 and his contributions to
2	Hoosier basketball.
3	SECTION 2. That the Secretary of the Senate transmit a copy of
4	this Resolution to Indiana State University.
