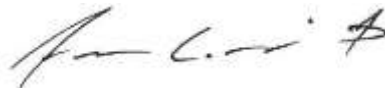
**SUBJECT:** Fiscal Note for HB 2636 by House Committee on Higher Education Budget

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning HB 2636 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

HB 2636 would authorize the State Board of Regents, on behalf of Pittsburg State University (PSU), to sell and convey all the rights, title, and interest subject to all easements and appurtenances in certain real estate located in Crawford County, Kansas.

With the enactment of HB 2636, PSU would retain the proceeds from the sale of the property; however, a revenue estimate from the sale currently is not available. In addition, once the property owned by the university is sold, PSU would no longer incur costs to maintain the property. Any fiscal effect associated with HB 2636 is not reflected in *The FY 2023 Governor's Budget Report*.
