1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas consumer protection act; relating to
2 unconscionable acts or practices.

4 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

5 Section 1. (a) The conduct prohibited by K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 21-6107,
6 and amendments thereto, constitutes an unconscionable act or practice in
7 violation of K.S.A. 50-627, and amendments thereto, and any person who
8 engages in such conduct shall be subject to the remedies and penalties
9 provided by the Kansas consumer protection act.

10 (b) For the purposes of the remedies and penalties provided by the
11 Kansas consumer protection act:

12 (1) The person committing the conduct prohibited by K.S.A. 2012
13 Supp. 21-6107, and amendments thereto, shall be deemed the supplier, and
14 the person who is the victim of such conduct shall be deemed the
15 consumer; and

16 (2) proof of a consumer transaction shall not be required.

17 (c) This section shall be part of and supplemental to the Kansas
18 consumer protection act and shall be known and may be cited as the
19 Wayne Owen law.

20 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
21 publication in the statute book.
